

HMRC to launch Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme service


HMRC has announced plans to open the online Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme (CJRS) service on 20 April. For further information on the CJRS, click here.

Latest business information:

TfGM offers free travel on Metrolink to key workers;

All staff employed by the NHS and Social Care and Care Worker organisations are now able to travel for free on Metrolink.

This includes:

 Adults and Children's Social Workers and Care Workers employed directly by local authorities and those employed by the private, voluntary and independent sectors including, those working in homecare, residential care homes and supported accommodation and re-ablement and those working in auxiliary roles regardless of who the employer is.

NHS staff and those providing critical services to the NHS or patients either employed directly by the NHS or by the private, voluntary and independent sectors including auxiliary roles.

Workers eligible to travel for free, should show (on request) the official identity badge issued by their employer or another proof of employment. Eligible workers who have already bought a 28-day Metrolink travelcard can apply for a refund. For further information, click here.

- Environmental Health Update; Since the UK entered lockdown on the 23rd March many businesses were forced to close. On this basis, Trafford Council's Environmental Team is providing a reminder about the risk of *Legionella* in vacant properties where water is allowed to stagnate within water systems. As a general principle, outlets on hot and cold water systems should be used at least once a week to maintain a degree of water flow and to minimise the chances of stagnation. To manage the risks during non-occupancy, consideration should be given to implementing a suitable flushing regime or other measures such as draining the system if it is to remain vacant for long periods.
