Featured Article

Trafford companies encouraged to apply for Coronavirus Business Support Grants

Trafford Council is calling upon eligible businesses across the borough to apply for their coronavirus grant support funding.

Businesses who haven't applied for the funding need to ensure they register and submit their bank details to the Council.

So far Trafford has paid out over £27m to more than 2200 businesses in the borough but has further funding to give to those eligible who have not yet applied.

There are two grants available – Small Business Grant and Retail, Leisure and Hospitality Grant – to be eligible for the Small Business Grant your business must be in receipt of Small Business Rates Relief or rural rate relief.

For the Retail, Leisure and Hospitality Business grants, businesses operating in the sector are eligible for a grant payment of £10,000 where the rateable value of their premises is £15,000 or less and £25,000 where the rateable value is greater than £15,000 and less than £51,000.

Loan scheme for large businesses expanded; Today the Chancellor announced that the government-backed loan scheme for large businesses affected by coronavirus has been expanded to cover all viable firms. All viable businesses with turnover of more than £45m will be able to apply for UK Government-backed support. Firms with turnover of more than £250 million can borrow up to £50 million from lenders. The scheme complements existing

support including the Covid Corporate Financing Facility and the Coronavirus Business Interruption Loan Scheme. For further information on the scheme click here.
