Trafford Council Launches Grant Application Process


Further to the Chancellor's announcement around financial support to assist businesses as a consequence of the COVID-19 epidemic, Trafford Council has today launched a dedicated webpage to enable local businesses eligible for grant funding to submit their application.

Businesses eligible for the Business Support Grants (Small Business Rates Relief) or the Retail, Hospitality and Leisure Business Grants can download a template of the appropriate letter to complete and return to Trafford Council. A facility for clients to submit their bank details is also included to facilitate payment.


Trafford Council is writing directly to eligible businesses however the online facility is designed to assist businesses who do not have access to their premises at this time.
